Position supervises line duty Captains in delivering emergency services, staff and project work, and other fire department operations. Function as Incident Commander, Sector Officer or Incident Safety Officer during emergency incidents involving multiple companies. Assists with developing departmental policies and procedures and manages major projects and programs.

The current assignment as EMS Program Manager is responsible for analyzing, planning, designing, implementing, and administering EMS programs. These include Advanced Life Support (ALS), Basic Life Support (BLS), Continuous Quality Improvement (QI), problem resolution, EMS certification/recertification, and other education and improvement programs.

The EMS Program Manager conducts research and analysis of current and future EMS issues and trends to ensure quality medical services. The EMS Program Manager assists in accomplishing established overall organizational goals through program management, provider and system evaluation, and quality assurance. The EMS Program Manager also serves as a liaison between the Fire Department, hospitals, ambulance providers, and other outside agencies.

Minimum Requirements:

- Valid Driver's License
- Minimum of six (6) years experience and three (3) years supervisory experience in the fire service or EMS
- Associate's Degree in Fire Science, Paramedicine, or Emergency Medical Technology
- Firefighter I and II certification
- Emergency Medical Technician or Paramedic certification
- Hazardous Materials Operation Level certification
- Fire Service Instructor certification

The ideal candidate will be disciplined, collaborative, and work with high integrity. In addition, he/she will possess demonstrated work experience with program/project management in the fire, rescue, EMS, public health or emergency medical field. Preferred qualifications include current certification/licensure as a Certified Emergency Paramedic, registered nurse, or physician's assistant, and current EMS instructor certifications.
